### **Venue**

The meeting will be held at the newly opened facilities of the Future Africa Campus ([www.futureafrica.science](http://www.futureafrica.science)) of the University of Pretoria, in Pretoria, South Africa.

### **Accommodation**

We have reserved accommodation at Future Africa for 5-8 November at a good rate, ZAR900pp for bed and breakfast (= approx. US\$65). ### **Post-meeting field trip**

There will be a post-meeting field trip from 8-11 November. The field trip will include exposure to South African plantation forestry, including visits to sites with infestation of some of the main pests of pine and eucalypts, such as *Sirex noctilio*, *Leptocybe invasa*, *Gonipterus* sp.2, as well as native insect pests. The field trip will also include exposure to some of South Africa's amazing native fauna and flora, with a visit to the Kruger National Park.

The cost of the field trip must still be finalized, but is estimated to be approx. US\$650 per person. This will include accommodation, all meals, and transport.

The numbers for the field trip need to be finalized soon to secure accommodation. Spaces for the field trip are limited, and will only be confirmed after payment.
